Khenpo Karma Wangyel

Is a brother of S.E. Gangteng Tulku Rinpoche, was born in 1964 in Trongsa (central Bhutan). He first studied at Semtokha High School and then moved to Kyabje Penor Rinpoche founded Shedra Namdröl Ling in South India in 1986 . In 1985 he met Khenpo Pema Sherab for the first time .

Pema Sherab, who had been invited by Gangteng Tulku Rinpoche in order to teach in Gangteng Gompa. Gangten Tulku Rinpoche had already suggested to his younger brother to become a monk, but he never convinced him.

But when Khenpo Pema Sherab offered to come to Namdröl Ling to study there, he was tempted by this idea.

So in the beginning of 1986 he set off for southern India with Khenpo Pema Sherab and finally finished the monastic vows.

He then began the nine-year study cycle established by Kyabje Penor Rinpoche.

After the intensive study of sutras, he spent the last three years studying tantras. After completing his studies, he was awarded the title of Lobbön.



Pema Lingpa

2500 years ago, Buddha Shakyamuni predicted that he would be followed by an even greater Buddha-one who would spontaneously be born on a lotus flower. This "second Buddha" was known as Padmasambhava, "the Lotus-born" or simply as Guru Rinpoche.

It was he who brought tantric Buddhism, also known as the "Secret Mantra Path", to Tibet and Bhutan during the eighth and ninth centuries.

He blessed the land with numerous Dharma treasures (terma), left many for future generations, hidden in the mountains, in trees or in the mental continuum of living beings (so-called spirit-termas). These treasures were predetermined, to be discovered by the 5 Tönnön kings or treasure hunter kings.

Of these 5 Treasure Hunt Kings, all of them Named "Lingpa", Padma Lingpa (or Pema Lingpa) represents the western compass, the Kingdom of Buddha Amitabha, as the emanation or charisma he applies.

Lineage holder of the Pema Lingpa line is His Eminence Gangteng Tulku Rinpoche, born. 1955, who is one of the great lamas and Dzogchen master of the Nyingma

tradition and head of numerous monasteries and temples in Bhutan.

He is the 9th incarnation of the great Terton (Treasure Finder) Pema Lingpa (1450 - 1521), a manifestation of Padmasambhava and Longchen Rabjampa (1308-1363). Khenpo Karma Wangyel has been Rinpoche's European residence lama since May 25, 2011, and we welcome him with sincere pleasure.

His base location is Pema Yang Dzong in Blyle / northern France. From here he visits all European Yeshe khorlo centers.. Khenpo Karma Wangyel is an exceptionally competent teacher and excellent educator. Gangteng Tulku Rinpoche himself said that he was one of his most outstanding khenpos. Khenpola teaches the Dharma at all levels and levels and is therefore a great treasure for us students in Europe.

Annotation :

The teachings will be given by Khenpola in English language.

Therefore, more detailed explanations are possible only in a later instruction. This event will focus more on applied practice and initiation.
