## . Rigdzin Düpa

The Rigdzin Düpa sadhana belongs to the Longchen Nyingthig (Heart Essence of the Great Expanse) cycle, which relates primarily to the teachings of Dzogchen. This cycle was bestowed upon Jigme Lingpa (1729-1798) through a series of three visions he had of the great master Longchen Rabjampa (1308-1363), and was soon propagated throughout Tibet, becoming one of the most influential lineages of the Nyingma tradition that continues to this day.

His Eminence Jigme Lodro Rinpoche was born in 1971 in Golok-Dhome of Tibet, and his birth was witnessed with various mysterious and auspicious signs. For example, one of the various auspicious signs was during the time of his birth, his mother's tent was surrounded by bright light and everybody could see clearly around the tent in the dark night. His birthday is in the same Tibetan year, same month and same day with Rigzin Jigme Lingpa who is the holder of Longchen Nyingthig in great Dzogchen lineages, and that date also is the anniversary of Longchen Rabjampa, He was recognized reincarnation of Genyen Dharmata by many Dzogchen masters before and after his birth. Genyen Dharmata was the server of the sixteen principal Arhat disciples of Buddha Shakyamuni, and was himself a realized master from the Alasha Monastery at Five Peaked mountain of China. When Rinpoche grew a little order, he naturally possessed habits in having compassion and bodhicitta with extraordinary intelligence. Since at the age of eight he learned and practiced Dharma from many masters at Talang monastery monastery in Golok, Gemang Hermitage Place, Larong-the city of Dharma in Serta, and many other Dharma places in Kham.

He had studied Sutras, Tantras and Tibetan culture and religion. After that, he became well-known for his unsurpassed qualities and knowledge. In 1996, he came to India and became a great editor in both the Tibetan-in-

exile government and the private editing centers. More than two hundred of his writings had been published inside Tibet and outside the Tibetan-in-exile communities. Some of his books were published by acclaimed publication centers of the Tibet governmentin-exile including the Department of Education, the Department of Information, as well as the Tibetan cultural and religious publication centers. His writings were wellrespected and complimented by many great scholars including H.H. Dalai Lama and Tibet government-in-exile. H.H. the Dalai Lama had sent a letter praising to Rinpoche for his writing in 1999. In 2005, H.E. Trulshig Rinpoche also recognized and declared that he is indeed the reincarnation of Genyen Dharmata. In accordance to that in January of 2005, H.H. Pema Norbu Rinpoche, the throne holder of the international Nyingmapa had enthroned Rinpoche in Bodhgaya in India during Nyingma Monlam event.

Rinpoche came to United State of America in 2007. He is currently residing in the United State and is the founder of Yeshede Buddhist Culture Institute. In October of 2011, Rinpoche received a Tibetan's the best literary award among 50 of other chosen candidates of Tibetan famous writers. Currently, Rinpoche is compiling additional historical stories of the Nyingma schools and the Tibetan culture and religion, giving Dharma teachings, practice advices to the local students and travel to give teachings in or states of U.S.A. and other countries.
