Chamtrul Rinpoche Lobsang Gyats

was born in Tibet and is recognized as the reincarnation of the second Katok Chamtrul Pema Nangsal Dorje Rinpoche from Mardo Tashi Chöling Monastery, one of Katok's branch monasteries. His first teacher was Naljor Yeshe Wangchuk Rinpoche, under whom he intensively studied and practiced Tummo and Dzogchen. Later, he studied at the Institute of Buddhist Philosophy at Katok Monastery and subsequently entered Shedra University at Larung Gar Monastery in Sertar, Eastern Tibet. During his studies with his root guru, Khenpo Jikme Phuntsok Rinpoche, he received the degree of 'Khenpo' and began teaching Madhyamaka, Pramana, and other subjects.

He was born in Tibet and is recognized as the reincarnation of the second Katok guru, Khenpo Jikme Phuntsok Rinpoche. When Jigme Phuntsok Rinpoche asked him to establish a Shedra in Mardo Tashi Choling, Rinpoche returned to his home monastery, where he taught and worked for the next six years. In 1999, he settled in Dharamsala, North India. There, Rinpoche teaches students from many different countries and travels around Rinpoche

travels the world to teach his students in the USA, Great Britain, Israel, Germany, Greece, Italy, Portugal, and other countries.

Rinpoche has been visiting our center for several years. We value him as a highly respected teacher of the Long Chen Nyingtik Dzogchen lineage and are extremely grateful for his dedicated teaching around the world, as well as at our center.

Vajracattva

The Vajrasattva practice (Tibetan: Dorje Sempa Wang) is one of the fundamental Vajrayana practices of Tibetan Buddhism.

In Vajrayana Buddhism, the Vajrasattva (Tibetan: Dorje Sempa) is a central Buddha who embodies purity of mind and the purifying power of enlightenment.

The Vajrasattva practice, combined with the 100-syllable mantra, is a profound tantric method for removing negative karma, obscurations, and obstacles.

Through initiation (Tibetan: Wang), this practice is ritually transmitted by a qualified lama to the students present, thus granting them the authorization to practice independently. The Longchen Nyingtik Ngöndro is often referred to as "The Excellent Path to Omniscience" and is A

fundamental practice to purify the mind and accumulate the necessary merit for the higher Dzogchen teachings.

The Longchen Nyingtik is one of the most important and widely disseminated teaching and practice cycles of Dzogchen (Ati Yoga) within the Nyingma school of Tibetan Buddhism. It was revealed in the 18th century by the great master Jikme Lingpa as a mind-terma (profound treasure).



Das Retreat - Haus Jigme Kunsang Ling
