Norbu Tsering Rinpoche

was recognized by Churi Lama "Jampa Guru" Rinpoche as the reincarnation of the Abbot of Dolpo Chicher Lang. Golok Serta Rinpoche's son, Tulku Tsewang Rinpoche, gave him the refuge vows and named him "Norbu Tsering." Even as a young boy, he received fundamental teachings and initiations, thus beginning his lama training very early and completing it by the age of twenty. Among other things, he received the entire "Jatson Nyingpo Cycle" as well as that of the "Rinchen Trengwa." Rinpoche spent nine years in Samye-Jedren Shedra studying the various texts. Norbu Tsering Rinpoche received all the Quintessence Instructions and transmissions of the Terma and Karma tradition. As an enthroned Vajra Master, Norbu Tsering Rinpoche has also undertaken retreats in the Dudjom Tersar tradition. For some time now, his main sphere of activity has been his own monastery, Pema Choling Drubtra..



Dudjom Lingpa 1835-1904

The "1000 Buddhas" associated with Dudjom Lingpa (1835–1904) refer to a vision and promise made by this important Tibetan master for the present age: that his emanations will continue uninterrupted as long as the teachings of the 1000 Buddhas of the Happy Age (Bhadrakalpa) endure.

Rinpoche will give this initiation to the 1000 Buddhas here on one of the most important Buddhist holidays, Sangye Nyangde Düchen, which celebrates the enlightenment and parinirvana of Buddha Shakyamuni. Furthermore, positive actions are said to be multiplied a hundred thousandfold on this day, which is why Buddhists use it to intensify meditation and cultivate mindfulness and generosity. praktizieren.
